The 9th annual USJF National Kata Clinic will be held August 7-9, 2009 in Tumwater, Washington near the state capital of Olympia. Tumwater is approximately 45 minutes south of Seattle and 90 minutes north of Portland, Oregon. Each day of the clinic will include 3-4 hour sessions. There will be instruction in Nage no Kata, Katame no Kata, Ju no Kata, Kime no Kata, Goshinjutsu, and Itsutsu no Kata. Testing will also be conducted for certification as a USJI or USJF kata instructor or judge.

Clinicians:

We are pleased to welcome head clinician **Eiko Shepherd, 7th Dan**. Shepherd Sensei is one of the leading judo kata experts in the US and is certified to teach all 7 Kodokan kata. Sensei is a USJI National Coach (Class C), USJI World Masters Level Teacher, USJI Kata Judge (Class A), USJF Kata Instructor (National Class A), USJF Chairperson - Kata Development, and Certified Class A in all seven Kodokan kata.

Shepherd Sensei will be assisted by Frances Glaze, 5th Dan, Mike Purcell, 6th Dan, and Delynn Purcell, 5th Dan.

Glaze Sensei is a USA Judo National level kata instructor, USJF Class A Instructor, USA Judo Class A Kata Judge, USA National Kata Champion, PJU Kata Champion, and World Masters Kata Champion.

Purcell Sensei (Mike) has been teaching kata for forty years, and is a USA Judo Class A Kata Judge in all seven Kodokan Kata

Purcell Sensei (Delynn) is a World Master's Grand Champion, PJU Silver Medalist, USA National Kata Champion, Fukuda Grand Champion, Kodokan Certified in Ju no Kata, and a USA Judo Class A Kata Judge in all seven Kodokan Kata.

This year's clinic will include a slightly different format. There will be 2 general sessions for all clinic participants to learn and practice more popular kata. There will also be 2 breakout sessions where instruction in two kata will be performed concurrently. Participants will have the opportunity to select a kata they would like to learn and practice.

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2.
