2. Those USJF teachers certified prior to 2000 are grandfathered given 1st aid/CPR, background checks, and is a member in good standing. Attach a copy of previous certification by USJF to the application.
3. Formal written outcome will be provided to the applicant by NTIS Chairperson.
4. The NTIS Committee will award the certificates which will be issued by the National Office.
