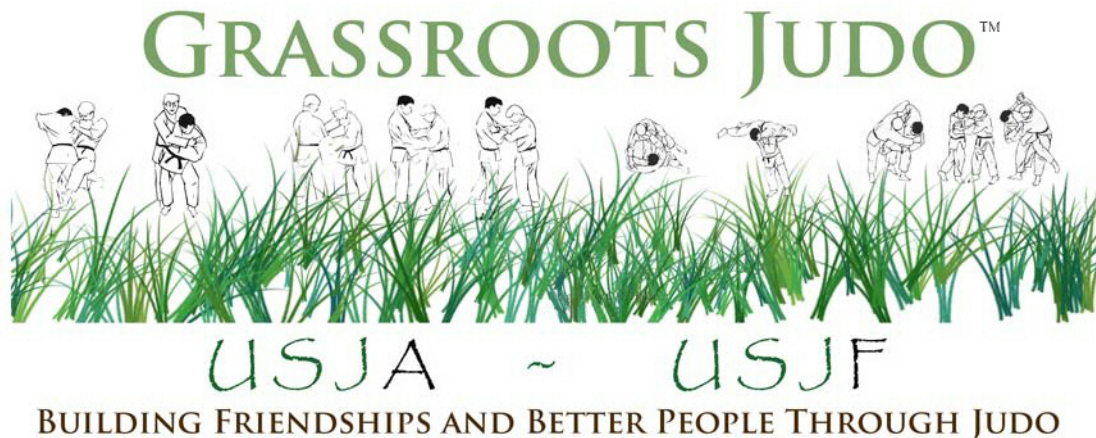


National Sponsored Workshop Policies and Procedures



Policy:

All USJF or USJA tournaments and events desiring the Grassroots Judo™ endorsement must formally apply to the leadership of Grassroots Judo™ through either of the Presidents or Executive Directors of USJF or USJA.

Procedure

- 1) A request for Grassroots Judo™ endorsement should be received no later than 3 months before the targeted date for the activity.
- 2) The applicant will submit a copy of the flyer/general information for review by the Grassroots Judo™ leadership committee
- 3) The leader who has received the request for endorsement will agendaize the request for the next joint USJA/F meeting.
- 4) After the review by the Grassroots Judo™ leadership committee will correspond to the applicant in writing or email with one of the following options:
 - a) Accept the event and event materials as proposed
 - b) Request further clarification about information on the flyer for further reconsideration
 - c) Deny the application and let the applicant know the reasons for the denial
- 5) If the application is approved, the applicant shall apply for and properly obtain a sanction for the event through the USJA/F.
- 6) The applicant will be required to:
 - a) Agree to one-time use of the Grassroots Judo™ for this specific activity only and control/limit the distribution of the Grassroots Judo™ logo in it's electronic/computer form
 - b) Incorporate the Grassroots Judo™ logo into the paperwork for the event
 - c) Agree to delete/remove all copies of the Grassroots Judo™ logo from the computer(s) utilized to: produce and create the paperwork, promotional materials, & etc. for the event
- 7) At the end of the event the applicant will submit an article and photographs from the event, giving the USJA/F publishing permission, so that they may be included in any of the USJA/F media materials (i.e.. website, magazine)
