The 2018 USJF National Kata conference was held in Honolulu, Hawaii at the Ala Wai Golf Course Ballroom on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, August 2, 3, and 4, 2018. The head clinician was Eiko Shepherd, Chairperson of the USJF Kata Development & Certification Committee. She was assisted by Wilina Monar and Leeanne Oue. The clinic covered Nage No Kata, Katame No Kata, Ju No Kata, Kime No Kata, Goshijutsu, Koshiki No Kata, and Itsutsu No Kata. There were a total of 54 participants with attendance each day of 41, 39, 47 on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, respectively.
