US Judo Hall of Fame Nomination Instructions

Dear US Judo Hall of Fame Nominator

Thank you for considering making a nomination for a candidate to the US Judo Hall of Fame. Submissions must be signed and by the current Yudanshakai President or a member of the US Judo Hall of Fame member. Nominations should be for individuals from their own Yudanshakai. Nominations for an individual should be for either the Hall of Fame or Lifetime Achievement, NOT for both.

The steps to submit your candidate are as follows:

- 1) Determine if your candidate meets the specific nomination criteria for:
 - a) US Judo Hall of Fame Award Website: <https://www.usjf.com/committees/hall-of-fame-committee/>
 - Successful Worlds and/or Olympic Athlete
 - Coach
 - Tournament
 - Program Administrator
 - Other Major Contributions
 - Judo Pioneer
- 2) Complete a typed Hall of Fame nomination packet. The packet will consist of
 - a) Nomination form found on the US Judo Hall of Fame Award Website; <https://www.usjf.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/02/020321-US-Judo-HoF-Fillable-Nomination-Form-1.pdf>
 - b) A formal picture of candidate (eventually to be used on website and for announcements)
 - c) A biography (background summary (prose)) supporting the nomination which may include:
 - (1) Judo credentials
 - (2) Action pictures
 - (3) Any other supporting documentation
