In regards to some of the challenges verifying Foreign Dan Rank Promotions from the country's National Judo Organization; I would like to propose that when the USJF National Off ice is unable to obta in a response from the country's NationalJudo Organization for rank verification that the Yudanshakai be given the authority to verify foreign Dan rank promotion certificates based on their rank authority.

The Yudanshakai validation will be based on the foreign Judoka meeting the USJF and Yudanshakai Dan criteria for promotion.

- 1. Unquestioned moral character and maturity.
- 2. Continued practice and contributions
- 3. Judo terminology and translation for techniques required for the Dan rank (s).
- 4. Meets the Proficiency level of the Dan rank (s) possessed technically and knowledge wise.
- 5. Knowledge and proficiency of the Kata required for the Dan Rank (s).
- 6. Yudanshakai promotion requirement for Dan(s).

That any USJF club can promote to Shodan provided that they meet the following requirement along with the ir Yudan shakai Board of Examine rs endorsement of this motion:

- I. Any club USJF coach, USJF Assistant coach, or USJF Assistant instructor can petition the USJF Head C lub I nst ruc to r for their approval to test their student for the rank of Shodan. Once the Head Instructor agrees to the proposal, he/she will contact the Chair of the Board of Examiners of the Yudanshak ai and the Chair of the Promotion Committee along with an electronic submission of a correct Form 20, Heads Up, and Safesports certification. Certificat io n for minors is not required. If the candidate is also a non-competitor, they must also send a USJF Coach or Teachers certification to the Yudan shaka i Chair of the Board of Examiners and the Chair of the Promotion Committee for their approval to test.
- 2. Once the Chairs gives approval to test the candidate, the examination must be conducted by at least three USJF examiners who have at least the rank of USJF Sandan and one must be USJF certified in Nage no Kata with at least a ·' B" certification. The score sheets from each of the examiners will be sent to the Chair of the Board of Examiners when the candidate passes his or her exam.
- 3. The candidate will then submit a background check to the Nation al office. If a minor, not needed for background check.
- 4. The Yudanshakai Chair of the Board of Examiners will elec tronic ally send a bill to the candidate for all their promotion fees. Once collec ted, the Chair of the Board of Examiner will then process their Form 20, Head s U p, and Safesports certification n and a Coach or Teacher's certification, if needed, to the National office for processing their promotion certificate.

That all USJF promotions for Shodan and above must have a current Heads up, Safesports, CPR, and first aid certification and will be submitted along with the candidate Form 20 to National Office.

PROMOTION PROCEDURES

Yudanshakai Promotions

Each member Yudanshakai member is given promotional authority to a particular rank, depending upon the length of time as a Yudanshakai, and the number and rank of Yudansha. Each Yudanshakai shall establish its own procedures for examination of candidates and awarding of promotions within its USJF authorized promotion authority. The USJF has established the following guidelines for Yudanshakais in the evaluation and review of promotion applications.

Each Yudanshakai shall hold at least two promotional evaluation examinations each year. To accomplish this, each member Yudanshakai shall create a Yudanshakai Board of Examiners, whose members shall be the higher-ranking members in the Yudanshakai. When a Yudanshakai's Board of Examiners consists entirely of examiners below the rank of Yodan (4th Degree Black Belt}, each examiner shall vote on candidates by casting votes equal to his or her rank: e.g., a Shodan would cast 1 vote, a Sandan would cast 3 votes, etc. Otherwise, all examiners shall have an equal vote.

The Yudanshakai Board of Examiners shall review the promotion application of each member, according to specific criteria for rank being considered. Yudanshakais may adopt or modify the following USJF guidelines for promotion within each Yuda nshakai's promotion authority, but such standards must be followed for promotion to rank beyond such authority.

Promotion applications that are beyond the promotion authority of the Yudanshakai shall be submitted for review by the National Promotion Committee.

Rank Requirements

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

There are general requirements for promotion that must be satisfied as a precondition for promotion, regardless of rank in question. Promotion of individuals who are not members of the USJF is not allowed. Testing and evaluation may be conducted by a combination of oral, demonstrative, and/or written examinations.

Elig ibility for promotion shall be based upon the following general requirements, not necessarily in this order:

- a. Moral character, att itude, and maturity
- b. Competitive ability
- c. Technical proficiency
- d. General experience, contributions, and time in grade
- e. Recommendation by candidate's instructor

Time in grade

Time in grad is the time spent at the applicant's present rank and is not cum ulative from the date of any previous promotion. Time in grade is computed from the time the candidate's present rank was registered with the National Office and is determined solely from the number of years of USJF annual registration since last promotion.

Promotion Points

Promotion Points may be counted for only one specific promotion and may not be carried over for considerati on in other rank advancements. Points may be credited only for wins against opponents for equal or higher rank and must be obtained in either USJF "sanctioned" events or other event as specified by Yudanshakai Board of Examiners or USJF Board of Examiners. An Opponent may count only once in tabulation of tournament points for any particular rank. Promotion evaluation contest may be held for the purposeof substantiating the candidates' competitive ability.

Shiai Promotional Points are typically earned by wins over opponents of equal rank, in qualified tournaments, Ippon wins over an opponent of equal ranks is one (1) point, while a Wazaari win over an opponent of equal rank is one-half (1/2) point. Yudanshakai may also elect to award promotion points to candidates defeating opponents of higher or lower rank. A recommended guideline is as follows:

If there are fewer than four (4) teams competing then the number will be cut in 1/2.

Kata Competitors that are selected by USA Judo to represent the USA in international Kata competition will become a "C" level classification. Placing 1'\ 2nd or 3rd in International competition will become a "B" level competitor.

Batsugun Promotions

A Yudanshakai may develop its own requirements for Batsugun promotions in a single promotional tournament. A recommended Batsugun promotion within single promotional tournament results from four (4) consecutive lppon wins over opponents of same rank for promotions up to lkkyu, and five (5) consecutive wins over opponents of same rank for Dan prom otions. If a contestant beats an opponent of higher rank, the win must be by lppon to qualify for Batsugun promotion; else, it simply counted a normal promotion point.

Candidate Classification

In order to properly evaluate candidates for promotion, two classifications of judoka are establi shed.

a) Competitors :

A competitor may have less time in grade and will be given greater weight for his or her competitive accomplishments towards his/her promotional consideration.

b) Non-competitors:

A non -competitor is an active member, who part icipates and contributes at all levels of the sport except for competition . Non-competitor may be examined and promoted in the same basic manner as competitors except that requirements shall be strict er, including longer time in grade. A non-competitor may change his classification to that of a "competitor" provided he/she passes all other requirements outlined for "competitor".

A major promotion criterion for non-comp etitor is service to the USJF. Contributio ns by non-competitors can be made at several different levels, includingdojo, Yudansh akai, national or international levels. Majo r contribut ions in these areas for the USJF can be to offset required points or Time in Grade.

Placing 1'', 2nd or 3rd in US Senior National Kata Champion ship s, Pan American Judo Union **Kata** Championsh ips, World Masters International Kata Comp etition, or any event that reaches the level of international involvement.

D. Competes in shiai and / or kata in any sanctioned tournament and earns points according to number of wins (includes Masters' competition) (this eliminates the D & E)

- D. Placing $1' \ 2^{nd}$, or 3^{rd} in Masters category at the U.S. Senior Nationals
- E. Competes in shiai and/or kata in any sanctioned tournament and earns points according to number of wins (includes Masters' competition)

MISCELLANEOUS

- 1. For Dan promotion s: Form #20 must be typed. Complete items 1 through 9 in full; be specific and informative. Unanswered categories on Form #20 may result in rejection or tabling of the application. The applicant and other responsible persons involved in completing Form #20 should not assume that the Board of Examiners or Promotion Committee will supply missing information. Again, fill outForm #20 completely or risk delay in processing the application.
- All Dan promotion applications above the rank authority of the Yudanshakai must be mailed to the National office at least 45 days prior to the announced USJF Promotional Committee meeting together with correct USJF Dan fee and copy of the candidate's current Dan certificate, to be considered at the meeting.
- 3. Applications for Godan and higher rank that are rejected cannot be resubmitted for at least two years. Applications for Yodan and lower that are rejected cannot be resubmitted for at least one year. CLARIFICATION: An application which has been "tabled" upon due consideration or that been "withdrawn" by Yudanshakai shall not be treated as a "rej ected application".
- 4. Dan rank awarded by other Judo organizations will be acknowledged by USJF; however, USJF ratification or certification of any rank will require at least three years of continuous USJF membership (two years in case of promotion to Shodan) immediate ly preceding application and the following proof that all USJF requirements for such rank have been satisfied. The required period of continuous USJF membership shall be counted from the current year membership as well as membership paid (as explained below) for the immediate preceding year in the case of Shodan rank and three preceding years in the case of rank above Shodan. Whenever a gap exists in the required period of continuous USJF membership, a makeup fee will be charged for each required year of continuous registration in an amount equal to that portion of the current annual membership fee payable to USJF exclusive of any portion of the membership fee attributable to insuranceor annual registration fee payable to the Yudanshakai.
- 5. USJF Dan fee assessments are \$30 for Shodan , and an additional \$10 for each rank above Shod an.
